# Directives for a print PDF in conformity with Medibel+ guidelines

## 1. The size

Respect the required dimensions for your advertisement. All available sizes can be found on the site of Trustmedia (<https://trustmedia.be/en/node/131>)

### Newspaper

no bleed, the exact size is sufficient

### Magazine

**bleed of 10 mm** (obligatory on each side of the advertisement) so we can correctly process your material


### Pano

double page in magazine


- 1 PDF, not 2 separate PDFs
- bleed of 10 mm (obligatory on each side of the advertisement) so we can correctly process your material







## 2. The colours


### Print (magazines and newspapers)

convert all used colours (images, text, logos, background colours ...) to **CMYK**.  
 All newspaper ads are printed on the salmon pink font of the newspapers.  
 Colour spaces such as RGB, PANTONE, indexed colours, Lab-colour mode ... will not be accepted.



## 3. Images

- Respect the minimum required resolution for images (don't use the standard resolution for web 72 dpi)
- Convert images to the CMYK colour space in format TIFF, EPS or JPG
- Make sure all images are embedded in the PDF

### Newspaper

200 dpi (normal)  
 800 dpi (bitmap)

### Magazine

300 dpi (normal)  
 1200 dpi (bitmap)

**Note:** images/sizes that are too heavy make the PDF heavier



## 4. ICC profiles

We recommend to use the ICC profile **IsoCoatedv2**.

Since the use of the correct colour profile is very important for an optimal printed result, please include the used profile in the file name fo the ad: "name\_IWC.pdf".


An alternative is the **IsoNewspaper26v4** for ads in newspapers.

Since the use of the correct colour profile is very important for an optimal printed result, please include the used profile in the file name fo the ad: "name\_INP.pdf".



## 5. Transparency

Please delete all parts in "transparent mode" in Indesign and Illustrator



## 6. Fonts

- Use a Font **OpenType, PostScript ou TrueType**
- Avoid imported fonts of other systems
- In case you use an imported font, we recommend to **vectorize** it. In this way, your font won't be identified as corrupted and won't be replaced by another font.

### Installation


Simple and unique installation

- InDesign/File/Adobe PDF Presets/
- Choose « Define » in the submenu
- Select « Load » in the next window

Choose the downloaded files « jobOptions » (NewspaperAds and MagazineAds)

### Use

- File/Export
- Select « Adobe PDF » in the menu of the window
- Select the preset parameter « NewspaperAds » of « MagazineAds » in the menu without changing other parameters


